## Pets in the Park

Being a responsible pet owner means much more than just providing food, water and shelter for your pet. Be aware of weather conditions and keep identification on your pet. Please don't let your pets run loose in the park and please pick up after your pets. We want everyone to enjoy the park. Kids and adults as well as pets.

The City of Saskatoon Animal Control Bylaw requires:

- all dogs and cats must have licenses and be wearing their tags (unless micro-chipped);
- dogs and cats may not run at large; and
- owners must clean up after their pets.

Zero Tolerance Enforcement:

Zero tolerance enforcement means that if you are caught violating the Animal Control Bylaw or the Dangerous Animal Bylaw, you will get a ticket.

Animal Control:

The Saskatoon Animal Control Agency (SACA) (306-384-7297 - 24 hours) is under contract to the City to provide animal control services.

- Reporting of animals at large;
- Reporting barking and howling;
- Complaints regarding defecation; or
- Reporting of dangerous animals.

NOTE: Incidents involving barking dogs will require the complainant to complete a 5-day and 7-day barking log. This log is used in court as evidence of the actual barking, including times and duration.

Join in on "The Big Shred" on Saturday, May 10 from 9 AM to 12 Noon in the McClure United Church parking lot at McKercher and Taylor.

At this secure site, you can watch as your documents are deposited into the local Shred-it company truck shredder! Protect you and your family against identity theft by safely destroying unwanted confidential, private, and personal documents rather than disposing them in non-secure city bins. This includes anything no longer needed that contains personal information. For example: credit card slips and receipts, bank information, utility statements, class notes, old pay stubs, dated income tax forms, store receipts, business cards, letterhead, business forms, office contact lists, financial reports, customer data, and proprietary information.
