The **Wildwood Rink** is ready to go for another great outdoor skating season. The rink lights are on each day from dusk until approximately 10:30pm. The warm up shack is open Tuesdays and Thursdays (sometimes other evenings) from 5:00-9:00pm, and Sundays from 2:00-4:00pm. If you use the ice and the shack is open, feel free to use the shovels to scrape the ice—but please return them to the shack when you are done. If you scrape the ice please push the snow all the way to the boards and remove it from the ice so that the edges are not curved upwards.

When using the rink please provide room for all patrons to use the ice (skating and hockey), treat other skaters with respect at all times, and keep food and drinks off the ice surface as it may damage our snowblowers and the ice. Please remember that the rink is for use by anyone regardless of age, and to act respectfully when there are young children and/or families present.

Thanks to all the great volunteers who've put in many hours to get the ice in and keep it maintained for everyone to enjoy. The rink is regularly maintained by volunteers who work hard to make sure it is in good shape for everyone.
